

ORDINANCE
2004-07

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WALTON COUNTY CODE TO REQUIRE WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION FROM THE COUNTY AND CONTIGUOUS PROPERTY OWNERS FOR VENDING ON PUBLIC BEACH PROPERTY, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that the safety, health, and welfare of the citizens of, and visitors to, Walton County would be best protected by the regulation of activities on public beaches;

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners finds that it is in the public's best interest to regulate vending on public beaches;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners to adopt the following:

Section 1. Authority; purpose and intent.

This ordinance is adopted pursuant to Section 125.01 Florida Statutes.

Section 2. Section 22-60 Beach Vendors is amended to read

- (8) No vending on private property without written authorization from the property owner. ~ vending on public beaches shall occur without written authorization from the county and any private property owner whose southern property line is contiguous to the proposed vending location.

Section 3. Severability

Should any word, phrase, sentence, or section of this ordinance be held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be illegal, void, unenforceable, or unconstitutional, then such shall be severed from this ordinance and the remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date


This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.


